AIM: VetBioNet seeks to strengthen European capacity and competence to meet the challenges of emerging infectious diseases by establishing a comprehensive network of European BSL3 infrastructures, international organizations and industries.

VetBioNet is dedicated to advance research on epizootic and zoonotic diseases and to promote technological developments.

Specific objectives:

- Promote and facilitate Transnational Access to VetBioNet Infrastructure resources, including BSL3 animal experimental facilities and laboratories, technological platforms, and sample collections.
- Promote scientific and technological development.
- Enhance the preparedness of the major European BSL3 research infrastructures to accelerate the respond to (re)emerging epizootic and zoonotic threats.
- Harmonise best practices and promote the use of global standards in European BSL3 infrastructures.
- Ensure high ethical standards and clarify the social impact of VetBioNet activities.
- Develop and implement a sustainability plan for offering services beyond the project length.
- Carry out joint research activities to improve scientific and technological standards of services provided by the network infrastructure.
